### Work Activities

## **NEW SITE**

Work is continuing on the CMR site in preparation to commencement of construction.

The amended landscape plan has been prepared and submitted.

Dick and John have been taking level on the block and most tracks are 1:90 to 1:120. The back straight on the 71/4 track is roughly 1:80 to 1:100. Waiting on the Engineer to sign off on the plans before construction can commence.

The insurance company has approved the use of Lexon glass in the toilet block and will cover the cost of this glass in the claim.



A working bee was held at the CMR block on Saturday 1<sup>st</sup> May. The purpose of the working bee was to install the security screens to the toilet

block, Install the double gates to the block and to clean up along the fence line and remove the thorn bushes. All work was completed and the morning gave members a chance to wander the block and see for themselves to amount of work required. The committee wished to thank all those who turned up on the day.

The Committee will be calling on members in the near future to undertake tasks associated with the new site once work gets under way. (watch this space)
