The rest of the meeting was taken up with discussions on the upcoming Invitation Run and the break in at the CMR. The meeting closed at 21:15.

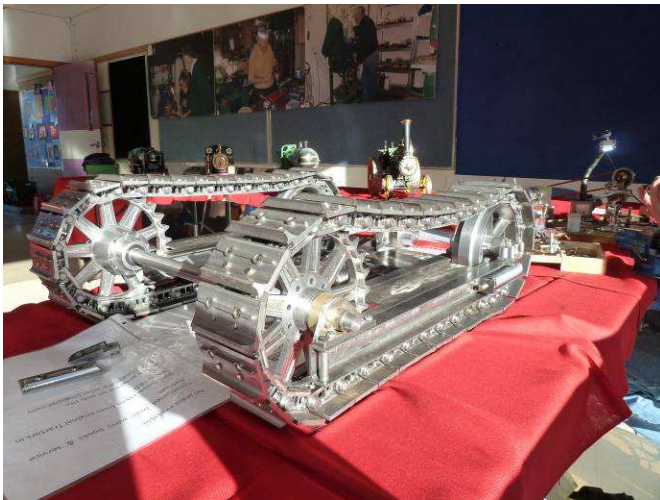
MALKARA REPORT

The award for best item of Rolling stock going to Reg Smith for his Queensland Railmotor.

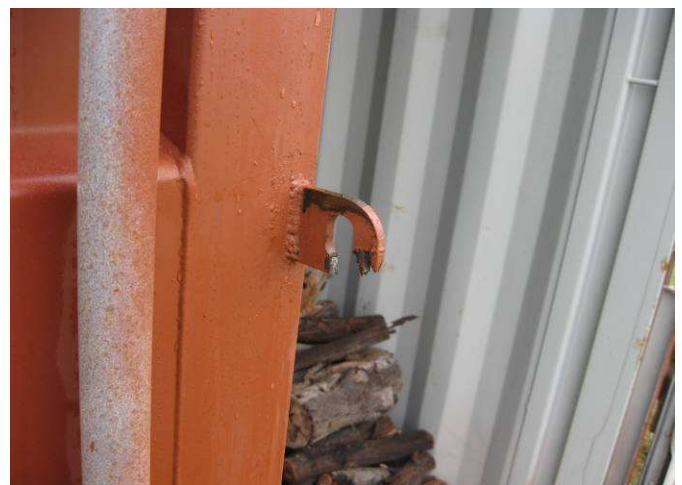

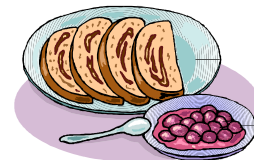
