COMMITTEE REPORT

The Committee meetings held in October saw discussions mainly concentrated on progress at the CMR site. The method of construction of the 7.25" track was discussed and agreed. A motion was tabled to be dealt with at the next Committee meeting. The motion from Bob Hesse is to hold an Annual Birthday Party Cake Competition. A motion was raised to investigate the re-introduction of an All Day Ticket. The Committee decided to survey the public over the next three monthly running days to gauge public support on the matter. Two new members were admitted to the Club. They are James Wellham and Joe Petre.

CMR

John Oliver has met with Ray Brown from ACTPLA to discuss signage on the CMR block. The outcome of the meeting was that CMR could have a 600mm x 600mm sign on the gate across the old Jerrabomberra

John Oliver has suggested that the station end facing the car park has a sign which states "Canberra Miniature Railway - Station entrance". The lettering should be of a size which can be read from the furtherest part of the car park.

Work is progressing on the new site – to date 5 of the container footings have been poured. The remainder of the footings along with the toilet block footings should be completed in October.

40+ trees have been planted and are doing well. The only problem so far appears to be some very large rabbits nibbling on some of

the trees. These will need to be wrapped in hession to prevent further damage.

The station has been erected during the month as planned.

Ian Smith has volunteered to start building the 7.25' track and has requested the Committee decide on the method of construction

Initial lengths of track are 3 x 6m lengths of 7.25' and 3 x 6m lengths of 5'. These are required for the station and will be concreted in.
